LFCA Football Clinic

The Louisiana Football Coaches Association has secured the Sheraton Hotel located at 500 Canal Street in New Orleans as site of its 2006 Football Clinic on Friday, December 8, 2006.

The clinic will begin with a pair of speakers (offensive and defensive) starting at 10 AM. A second set of speakers will follow at 11 AM and then we hold our luncheon. Immediately following lunch and business meeting we will have a full slate of afternoon speakers to close out our expanded clinic.

We have included the 2006 Clinic Agenda on Page 2 of this newsletter. Please note that if you pre-register and pay your dues before December 1, 2006 they will be \$30, after that date (at the clinic) they will be \$40.

Room Reservations at Sheraton

We were able to secure 200 rooms at the Sheraton for those of you interested in staying at site of the clinic. Of course, you will have to renew your membership for 2007 (the application is on page 4 of this

newsletter) please be sure to check the box that you would like a room and send your application and (\$30) check to Coach Baglio (address on application). Coach Baglio will mail you your blue 2007 Coaches Card and a form from the Sheraton. You will fill it out, fax or mail it to the Sheraton. Then you will have to wait two weeks, call the Sheraton and get your confirmation number. Deadline for the Sheraton to receive applications for rooms will be November 22, 2006. Rooms will be given out on a first come, first serve basis.
